## TRANSPORTATION

Pick-up will not be provided at the airport and transportation costs will not be reimbursed.

### By Taxi

From Terminals 1 & 2, taxi queues are at Terminal 1, Level E0, or follow the “Taxi” signs inside the airport.

From Terminal 5, taxi queues are at T5 “L” area, or follow the “Taxi” signs inside the airport.

Taxi trips from the Brandenburg airport to Berlin city center take around 40 minutes and the average fee is 50€. Official taxis have either Berlin, “B” or “LDS” plates.

### By Public Transport

The S-Bahn or U-Bahn trains are the quickest way to Berlin city centre. With a one-way 3.60€ ticket or better a 24h-ticket, which costs only 10 Euro for zone A/B/C. The trip from Airport to the city is lasting 50 minutes.
