The Latin American Association for Human Rights (ALDHU), strongly condemns the policy of mass banishments unleashed by the government of Daniel Ortega in Nicaragua.

The decision of the Nicaraguan dictatorship to expel from the country 222 political prisoners including journalists, social leaders, political opponents, democratic leaders, business leaders and young people emulates the worst repressive practices once used by the dictatorships of Videla in Argentina and Pinochet in Chile.

This repressive act is aggravated by the fact that the victims are deprived of their nationality, in what constitutes a serious violation of the human rights of those affected.

With these acts, Ortega has confirmed his dictatorial character by putting himself on the margins of the international community.

ALDHU draws attention to the gravity of the state of tyranny into which Nicaragua has plunged and urges democratic nations to severely condemn the dictator Daniel Ortega. And his government declaring it a pariah in the democratic community of nations.

ALDHU ratifies its solidarity with the victims of Ortega's tyranny and reiterates its strongest condemnation of the dictatorial government of Nicaragua.
