27-30 August 2025, Sulaymaniyah, Kurdistan Region, Iraq

Background

The Arab region continues to navigate a complex landscape marked by persistent authoritarianism, unresolved conflicts, and democratic erosion. The ongoing war in Gaza has further deteriorated prospects for peace, worsening humanitarian conditions and pushing international mechanisms for accountability and response to the breaking point. More than a decade since the Arab Spring, the region has yet to realize the ethos of that moment. In many cases, the same repressive structures that the uprisings sought to dismantle have not only endured—but reasserted themselves, often in more sophisticated and entrenched forms.

At the same time, shifting geopolitical dynamics—including new regional alignments and the growing influence of external powers—are reshaping strategic priorities and governance models in a region long characterized by volatility and political upheaval. In this context, progressive forces must confront these challenges head-on: examining root causes, building democratic alternatives, and advancing coordinated, principled engagement to address the shared crises they face.

Organized by the Social Democratic Alliance in the Arab World (SDA-AW) and the Progressive Alliance (PA), and hosted by the Patriotic Union of Kurdistan (PUK), this conference brings together progressive party officials along with







women's and youth organizations from across the region. The meeting aims to deepen solidarity between Arab and Kurdish progressive movements, reinforce cooperation across party structures, exchange experiences in programmatic responses and democratic governance, and lay the groundwork for a renewed political vision and strategic programme for social democracy in the Arab world.
